
UX Improvements


Upper Right Nav

The info button blends with the 3 dot menu, also this is an odd spot




Save Bar

Actuals | Forecast are easy to miss and the color differential is not good on bad monitors





Table (Menus)

Too many actions are hidden, we need to determine primary actions vs "overflow" actions. All primary should be available at all time and not hidden. Also, the expand icon isn't always available and the user has to rollover the "sweet spot" in order to see it.


Department


Drivers


Upper Right Navigation

The actions are hidden in the ... menu and are completely disconnected from the actual data




Edit Template



Setup


- The vertical orange line makes it feel like 2 different sections and it's far from obvious the left controls the right.
- The two "GO" buttons in the right column look like a proper call to action when in reality they launch a video.
- All the videos have the same opening frame, it is not obvious the videos change
- In the Getting started areas the actions on the right get lost in the "chaos."
- Crossing out completed tasks look like a CSS error not a checklist


Upper Right Navigation


The edit and overflow menus are hidden



Edit Modal


There is a pencil in place of the traditional X/close button

The save and cancel buttons are not visible, the user has to scroll to the bottom to see them. Now they don't have an easily accessible escape route.






Form Fields

I know it is "cooler and cleaner" to user underlines as form fields, but it is not obvious these are meant to be filled out.




Upper Right Navigation

Menu

- The menu structure lacks a visible hierarchy. When I was first introduced to the app I had no idea what was going on
- The left primary navigation relies entirely on icons and rollovers. Icons should never be a primary menu, they are good for secondary actions or highlight a menu

- In this image, it's the plan section. It was not clear that "Budget_1" was a plan. Also, the "PLAN ACTIVE" is confusing. I haven't found another state other than "ACTIVE."
- The hamburger menu icon is wrongly used here. The icon is not meant to be an expandable/collapseable icon, it s meant to be a primary menu icon.
